FUNCTIONAL CHANGES IN VERSION 7.04.01

GENERAL

ID	Classification	Feedback
38288	Bug	On search pages, when the "My" filter is enabled, a checkbox indicates that the filter is in use. If a user with permission unchecked "My," the filter still remained in the dropdown for filters. In previous versions, the filter was automatically cleared when "My" was unchecked. This functionality has now been restored.
38377	Bug	The text on the "Today" button in the date picker has not been displayed correctly when used in Finnish.
38550	Bug	The clear button in Search Owner/Location (Basic Registry) has not reloaded the default main organization.
38586	Bug	The API for test results has not accepted a NULL values in the Updated, even though the value was not mandatory. (Issue since version 7.04.00)
38662	Bugg	Permission to use filters on stock has, in some cases, incorrectly disallowed selection of stock/articles even though the permission was not activated.

WORKORDER

ID	Classification	Feedback
38106	Changed Functionality	It is now supported that a the same checklist can be used more than one time on the same work order.
38279	Bug	The Workorder form did not reload after the message was displayed indicating that a checklist was either incomplete or missing. As a result, after the message was shown, the workorder did not present certain information – for example, details about the current equipment.
38280	Changed Functionality	The report/document generated for the checklist has been added with information about the equipment number, serial number and work order number.
38349, 38384	Bug	For checklist entries of type Numeric, decimals have not shown correctly. The check against the lower threshold value has been performed with incorrect decimals, and negative threshold values have not been handled correctly.
38492	Bug	When using the default value for <i>N/A</i> in a checklist entry of type <i>Passed / Failed / N/A</i> , the wrong color was displayed for <i>Passed</i> .
38519	Changed Functionality	<i>Document type</i> has now been introduced for checklist procedures. The handling of the checklist report has been changed; it is now generated as a document when a checklist procedure is marked as complete. This means that a document is created with the preselected document type and placed under the <i>Documents</i> tab in the work order.
38617	Bug	The description text in a checklist entry was not shown correctly in the checklist on the work order.

SYSTEM

ID	Classification	Feedback
38563	Bug	An error message was displayed when creating a system without a code. This bug was new in version 7.04.00.

ADD-ON MODULE: HELPDESK

ID	Classification	Feedback
38283	Bug	Responses to the new types of control questions were not saved correctly when answered via the customer portal. As a result, tickets created through the Customer portal did not display any answers to the control questions.

ADD-ON MODULE: RENTAL

ID	Classification	Feedback
38323	Bug	When returning equipment on a rental agreement and choosing to create a one-time PM, an error message was displayed, and no PM was created.
